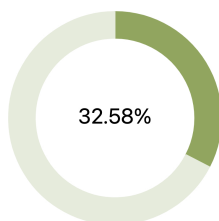

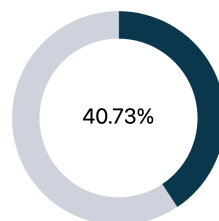

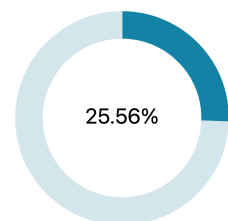

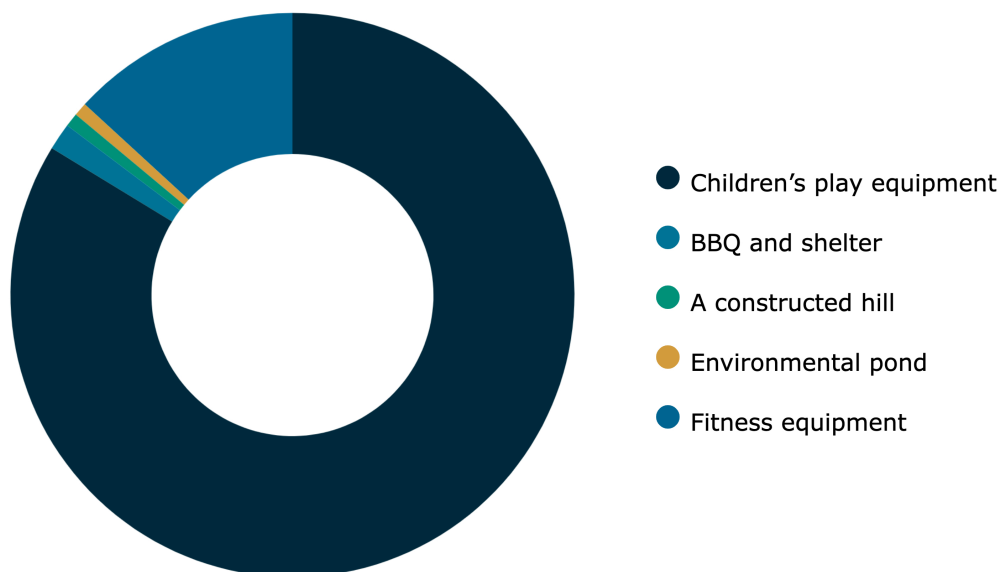

A different type of exercise apparatus should be installed</li> <li>2. Dont include a barbecue as it would likely be under utilised, if used at all.</li> </ol> <p>1. Instal exercise equipment similar to the Avenel fitness hub instead of the hitting wall and basketball ring.</p> <p>Since the original Whroovale reserve development proposal, council has installed a hitting wall and basketball ring at the Nagambie youth hub. The hub is only a few streets across from Whroovale reserve. Installing another hitting wall and basketball ring replicates equipment already available nearby for those whose interests lie in that area. Both apparatus require a medium level of aerobic fitness and agility, significantly limiting the age demographic that can utilise them.</p> |

|      |   |                           | <p>The Avenel fitness hub has equipment suitable for a far broader demographic, including beginners, seniors, people with disabilities or those undergoing rehabilitation. Currently exercise equipment in Nagambie is limited to a stationary bike and a sit up bench both situated alongside Blayney lane. It is in a relatively isolated location. Whroovale reserve provides easy access for all people.</p> <p>2. No need for a barbecue.</p> <p>River St and Buckley Park have barbecues, playgrounds, and the water. They also have amenities blocks. People, often tourists, go to these locations and set up for the day, swimming, fishing or paddling, and in the future, utilising the splash and water parks and foreshore walk.</p> <p>Whroovale reserve will likely be used only by local residents. With activities limited to the playground and exercise equipment and no amenities block, it is highly likely visits will be limited to a few hours. Residents may pack a picnic but unlikely to set up for a barbecue. The funds could be better spent.</p> |

|      |   |                           | <p>I believe that the current footpath needs to be moved away from the property boundary on the north west boundary.</p> <p>A move to introduce a gently sloped rise or plateau would be great. It introduces the "third dimension" to the area. It must be easy to maintain for the grounds staff. There should not be any dramatic changes of grade. I do not believe a "hill" of similar size to the manufactured hill at the entry to the "Sevens" estate at Kialla would be appropriate.</p> <p>Is it Council's intention to install an Australian Standard safe level of public lighting in reserves as part of the development?</p> <p>Council will also need to look outside the reserve to make sure that it is accessible-for-all. At the time of the last consultation there were no pram crossings at the entry points to the reserve from adjoining streets.</p> <p>Please ensure that park furniture is installed on concrete slabs, wide and long enough to allow quick grounds maintenance, and provide for wheelchair access to furniture. This matters also at the ends of tables where wheelchairs will be positioned, to provide an even stable surface.</p> <p>Will irrigation systems be installed?</p> <p>All softfall should be the rubberised softfall.</p> <p>Have the Parks and Reserve and/or grounds maintenance teams had input to the concept development?</p> <p>Please ensure that soil testing, and subsequent soil improvement and preparation, is undertaken to ensure that all planting have the maximum opportunity to "bloom and grow" (like edelweiss). The current soil surface does not appear to be arable/good growing soil.</p> <p>thanks for the opportunity to make a submission.</p> |
